## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK....

Burying the dead is one of the Corporal Works of Mercy. When Fr. John Gallagher was pastor here at the "Heart," he instituted a new ministry to assist the priest and the family at funerals. This ministry is vital and ensures that our funerals have the dignity they should. Over the course of their tenure, the Bereavement Committee has assisted at over 100 funerals. The ministers proclaim the sacred Word, minister the Eucharist and serve as acolytes. At present, there are approximately seven members of the parish who serve on the Bereavement Committee. I am grateful to these parishioners for their willingness to serve in this ministry. With a desire to identify their role as liturgical ministers, we recently purchased albs for the members of this committee to wear when serving at funerals. This highlights their roles in the liturgy where they also serve as representatives of the parish.

We have had several donations from families of our recently deceased in memory of their loved ones which have been used to purchase these albs. 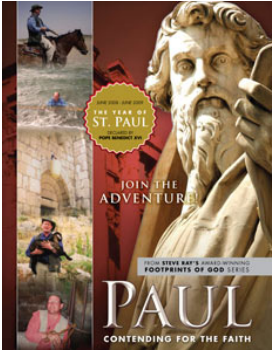

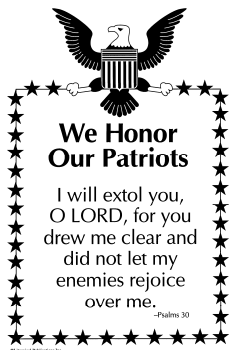
