WEDDING JUBILARIANS DURING 2009:

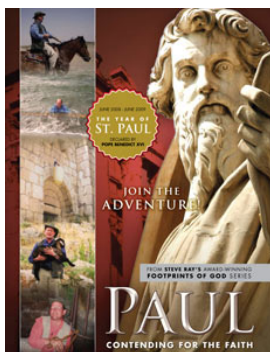

CATHOLIC WIDOWS & WIDOWERS

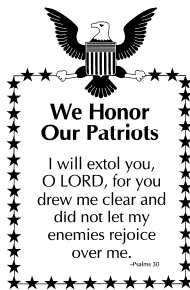
