### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK....

As we usher in 2010 I thought it would be good to look back and to reflect on the sacramental life of the Parish for 2009. Several parishioners marked milestones in the commitment to God and the Church through the reception of a sacrament. At Sacred Heart in the past year, 43 children were welcomed into the Christian community through the waters of baptism. 25 children in the second grade, 15 from our religious education program and 10 from our grade school renewed their grace of baptism though the sacrament of First Reconciliation. 32 children in the third grade, 14 from our religious education program and 18 from the grade school were welcomed to the Table of the Lord in the sacrament of First Holy Communion. 26 teenagers in the eighth, 5 from our religious education program and 21 from the grade school received the Seven Fold-gift of the Holy Spirit in the sacrament of Confirmation. 28 couples pledged to be signs of sacramental love and witnessed their marriage in our beautiful church. 67 parishioners embraced sister death and were remembered at funeral services. At the Easter Vigil 2 individuals were welcomed into Full Communion with the Catholic Church, 2 others completed their Sacraments of Initiation. The sacramental life of the church is alive and well. May we be renewed in our faith by their witness and commitment.

It also recommends that, if someone is not well, or has been exposed to someone who is not well, that they should refrain from receiving from the cup. Therefore, we ask that if you or someone in your immediate vicinity is ill, please forego the cup and resume when you are feeling better.

Another concern that has been brought up is shaking hands at the Sign of Peace. Again, if you are not well, a simple nod of acknowledgment is perfectly acceptable. We wish to keep everyone as healthy as possible.
