### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK....

**Dear Parishioners,**

**Today's letter is a continuation of last week's topic on the reception of Holy Communion.**

The following are excerpts taken from the **General Instruction of the Roman Missal** including the Adaptations for The Dioceses of the United States of America.

The **norm for the reception of Holy Communion in the dioceses of the United States** (*is that the communicant*) **is standing.** Communicants should not be denied Holy Communion because they kneel. Rather they should be addressed pastorally, by providing the faithful with proper catechesis on the reason for the norm.

**When receiving Holy Communion, the communicant bows his or her head before the Sacrament as a gesture of reverence and receives the body of the Lord from the minister.** The consecrated host may be received either on the tongue or in the hand, at the discretion of each communicant. When Holy Communion is received under both kinds, the sign of reverence (**bow of the head**) **is also made before receiving the Precious Blood.**

If communion is given only under the species of bread, **the minister raises the host slightly and shows it to each, saying the Body of Christ. The communicant replies, Amen, and receives the Sacrament either on the tongue or,** where this is allowed and if the communicant so chooses, **in the hand. As soon as the communicant receives the host, he or she consumes it entirely.**

Please follow these simple procedures so that your personal experience of the reception of Holy Communion is done with private reflection and proper dignity.

**SACRED HEART FOOD PANTRY**

We have been very fortunate at Sacred Heart to have a food pantry to help others facing financial difficulties. We are finding as we get to month's end that more people are in need of our help. We are finding that we are running low of certain items more frequently. We are asking that on your next shopping trip, perhaps you would pick up one or two items to contribute to the pantry. Items we are running low on are: canned fruits and vegetables, rice (plain or mix), potatoes (box), canned meats (chicken, ham, corned beef), beef stew, cookies, crackers, pancake mix (complete), pancake syrup, jell-o (sugar-free), Kool-aid powdered mix. Items can be dropped off in the vestibule of the church, marked food pantry or to the Parish Office. As always, we thank you for your help.
