OPERATION SUPPORT OUR TROOPS - A THANK YOU

Dear Friends,

Oh Thank you thank you thank you thank you thank you. If you didn't want to be thanked, TOO BAD! All of the nuts were a hit. I dropped off the box and went on leave 4 days later. I also just found out I am to be a father for the 3rd time, so I'm pretty excited about that. I returned to find just the single big bag of peanuts remained. I of course confiscated all of the Wasabi Peas and enjoyed them immensely. Thank you for your unending love of the American Servicemember.

There are A LOT more soldiers, airmen, and sailors here then were up at the ARST with 15th MI. Approximately 400 or so, but we don't need to share with everyone. Up in my office there are approximately 75 personnel between day shift and night shift. We are the single source enclave for III Corps in Iraq. We are comprised of Imagery Analysts, Signals Intelligence Analysts, Open Source Analysts, Human Intelligence Analysts, and Geospatial Analysts. We provide the Commanding General of United States Forces-Iraq the eyes and ears of the battlefield. These guys and gals are just as hungry for peanuts, walnuts, pistachios, cashews, pecans, almonds, hazel nuts, brazil nuts, macadamia nuts and corn nuts. I've also been told they love beef jerky, dried mango, cheese crackers, and gum. I of course, love those wasabi peas. Again, please no toiletries as every where I've been has been overstocked with them. Thank you again, one last time for all that you do. I know it probably gets hectic putting all these packages together, but if it wasn't for people like yourself providing us with all the comfort foods and items from the good ole USA we would be missing home even more. Have a great day and enjoy your moderate to warm summer. We will all be thinking of home when the temperatures rise well above the century mark. Drink a Long Island Iced Tea (if you drink) for me and dip your feet in a wading pool in your back yard. SGT RW
