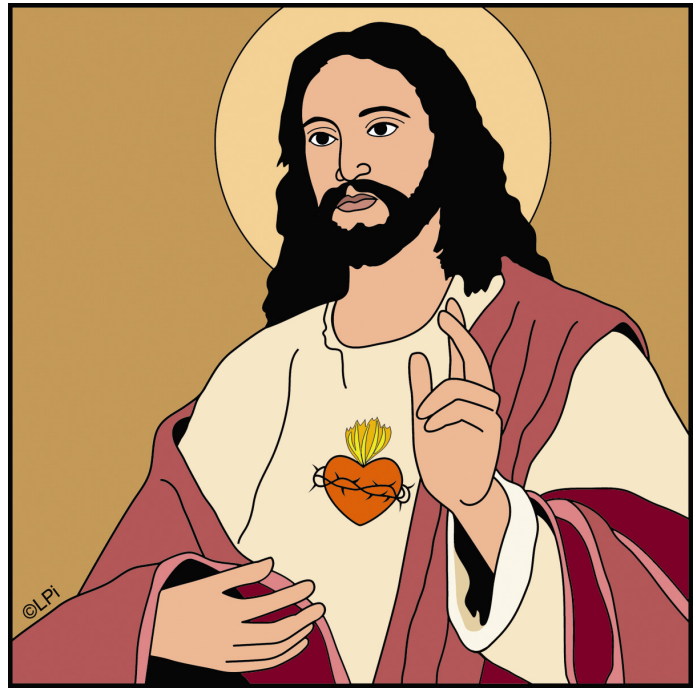


### **OPERATION SUPPORT OUR TROOPS**
