I have received notification from the Provincial Minister John Gallagher that the new Parochial Vicar who will replace Fr. Charles will be Fr. Andrew Nowak.

Fr. Andrew was ordained this Saturday (June 19th) at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish in Jamaica Plain, MA. He celebrates his First Mass today (June 20th) at Blessed Mother Theresa in Dorchester, Massachusetts. Fr. Andrew was born in Buffalo and raised in Western New York and spent much of his school years in Johnstown, PA. Before entering the Capuchin Order, Fr. Andrew was an investigator for New York State Child Protective Services. Fr. Andrew recently graduated from Boston College School of Theology and Ministry with masters degrees in divinity and theology. While living in Boston, Fr. Andrew worked with the Vietnamese and served as the chaplain to a Catholic elementary school.

Fr. Andrew's assignment is effective July 5th. I'm sure you will join me in extending a warm welcome to Fr. Andrew to Sacred Heart.

We have been very fortunate at Sacred Heart to have a food pantry to help others facing financial difficulties. **We are finding there are more people are in need of our help.** We are finding that we are running low of certain items more frequently. We are asking that on your next shopping trip, **perhaps you would pick up one or two items to contribute to the pantry.** Items we are running low on are: canned fruits and vegetables, rice (plain or mix), potatoes (box), canned meats (chicken, ham, corned beef), beef stew, cookies, crackers, pancake mix (complete), pancake syrup, jell-o (sugar-free), Kool-aid powdered mix. Items can be dropped off in the vestibule of the church, marked food pantry or to the Parish Office. As always, we thank you for your help.
