ALL SOULS DAY

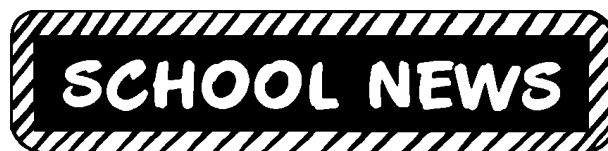

CATHOLIC LAWYERS' GUILD RED MASS

Walsh, D.D., Rector, St Joseph's Seminary and Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of New York will celebrate the Annual Red Mass for the Judiciary and Legal Profession and their families on Wednesday, October 29 at 6:00 pm at St. John the Evangelist Church, 148 Hamilton Ave, White Plains, NY.

The Red Mass is sponsored by the Catholic Lawyers Guild and is a solemn religious ceremony asking God to guide the legal profession toward the administration of justice. The custom dates back to Europe in the 13th century. In the United States, the practice was reinstated by the CLG in the New York Archdiocese in 1938.
