#### **AN EXCERPT FROM: "SOLANUS CASEY, THE OFFICIAL ACCOUNT OF A VIRTUOUS AMERICAN LIFE" THE PRACTICE OF THE VIRTUES BY SOLANUS CASEY *The Theological Virtues* The Practice of the Love of God**

Solanus nourished his intimate, loving relationship with God especially by constant prayer. His first biographer, James P. Derum, testified that he showed

love of God by the long hours that he spent in chapel, even when he was tired, praying and particularly praying for others. This was related to me by the members of the Capuchin Order as I talked to them in preparation for writing my book. It was related to me that oftentimes the janitor would come in to clean up the Chapel in the morning at 5 a.m. would find Father Solanus in the Chapel, sometimes asleep, indicating that apparently he had been there most of the night. When the person who found him expressed his amazement at finding him in the Chapel asleep, Father Solanus in his wry humor stated, "Oh, it wasn't so bad, I was sleeping on the soft side of the boards." I believe that his deep love for God is illustrated by this incident.
